Lion

Onghoshi / Ongeama / Xammi / Leeu / Panthera leo
• **ICUN Status:** Vulnerable
• **Habitat:** Plains or savannah
• **Diet:** Large hoofstock such as zebra or giraffe

Leopard

Ongwe / Ongwe / Garub / Luiperd / Panthera pardus
• **ICUN Status:** Near Threatened
• **Habitat:** Woodlands, savannahs, and forests
• **Diet:** Small and medium antelope, warthog, or primates

Cheetah

Etotongwe / Otjitotongwe / !Arub / Jagluiperd / Acinonyx jubatus
• **ICUN Status:** Vulnerable
• **Habitat:** Grasslands or deserts
• **Diet:** Small antelope, such as steenbok or duiker

Caracal

Eshinga / Orukuenjare / Aba / oas / Rooikat / Caracal caracal
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Woodlands, scrub forest
• **Diet:** Hyraxes, rodents, small antelopes, small monkeys, birds

Serval

Tierboskat / Leptailurus serval
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Reed beds and grasslands
• **Diet:** Small mammals and birds

African Wild Cat

Oshixwe / !Garo / Hoab / Wildekot / Felis silvestris
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Scrub desert
• **Diet:** Small mammals and birds

Small-spotted Cat

Black-footed cat / Klein gevlektekat / Felis nigripes
• **ICUN Status:** Vulnerable
• **Habitat:** Dry grasslands, savannahs, and deserts
• **Diet:** Small mammals and birds

Spotted Hyaena

Oshimbungu / Ombungu / Gara / #Hiras / Gevlekte Hiena / Crocuta crocuta
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Savannah or acacia bush
• **Diet:** Anything from spring hare to small wildebeest

Brown Hyaena

Oshimbungu / Ombungu / #Hiras / Bruin Hiena / Hyaena brunnea
• **ICUN Status:** Near Threatened
• **Habitat:** desert, semi-desert, open scrub and woodland savanna
• **Diet:** Opportunistic, anything from carrion to insects, reptiles, and mammals

Aardwolf

Ekundi / Proteles cristatus
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Dry, open savannahs or grasslands
• **Diet:** Termites

Wild Dog

Ombidi / Ohakane / !Gaub / Wildehond / Lycaon pictus
• **ICUN Status:** Vulnerable
• **Habitat:** Grasslands, savannahs, open woodlands
• **Diet:** Small antelope

Black-Backed Jackal

Kavandje / Ombandje / !Gireb / Rooi Jakkals / canis mesomelas
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Dry areas, open grasslands
• **Diet:** Rodents, hares, small antelope

Side-striped Jackal

Kourandje / Ombandje / Witkwasjakkals / Canis adustus
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Savannah or grassland
• **Diet:** Insects, fruits, small vertebrates, carrion

Cape Fox

Silver vos / Vulpes chama
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Arid savannah
• **Diet:** Small rodents, insects, small reptiles

14



Bat-eared Fox

Bak-oor jakkals / Otocyon megalotis
• **ICUN Status:** Vulnerable
• **Habitat:** Arid grasslands or savannahs
• **Diet:** Insects

15



Honey Badger

Shishi / Ondese / Ratel / Mellivora capensis
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Arid environments
• **Diet:** Anything from insects to offspring of small antelope

Suricate

Orupuka / Stoksterk / meerkat / Suricata suricatta
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Open plains or savannah
• **Diet:** Insects, small vertebrates

17



African Civet

Afrikaanse siwet / Civettictis civetta
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Forest or grassland
• **Diet:** Small animals

18



Cape Clawless Otter

Groototter / Aonyx capensis
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** In or near freshwater
• **Diet:** Crustaceans, molluscs, frogs, and fish

19



Spot-necked Otter

Kleinotter / Lutra maculicollis
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** High-quality freshwater
• **Diet:** Fish

20



Small-spotted Genet

Kleinkol muskeljaakat / Genetta genetta
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Dry forests
• **Diet:** Small animals

21



Large-spotted Genet

Rooikol muskejaakat / Genetta tigrina
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Well-watered woodlands
• **Diet:** Small rodents, birds, insects, and fruit

Striped Polecat

Nghandanga / Ondese / Stinkmuishond / Ictonyx striatus
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Grassland, woodland, savannah, and desert
• **Diet:** Small rodents

23



Striped Weasel

Slangmuishond / Poecilogale albinucha
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Savannah
• **Diet:** Small mammals, birds, snakes, and insects

White-tailed Mongoose

Witstermuishond / Ichneumia albicauda
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Savannah woodlands and grasslands
• **Diet:** Mainly insects

25



Yellow Mongoose

Cynictis penicillata
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Semi-arid, open grassland and scrubland
• **Diet:** Mainly insects, some small vertebrates

Slender Mongoose

Swartkwasmuishond / Galerella sanguinea
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Savannah, grassland, forest
• **Diet:** Mainly insects

27



Banded Mongoose

Gebandemuishond / Mungos mungo
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Grasslands, woodlands, rocky country
• **Diet:** Mainly insects

28



Selous's Mongoose

Klein mistertmuishond / Paracynictis selousi
• **ICUN Status:** Not assessed
• **Habitat:** Savannah grassland or woodland
• **Diet:** Insects, lizards, birds, and small rodents

29



Small Grey Mongoose

Klein grysmuishond / Galerella pulverulenta
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Dense bush or rocky outcrops
• **Diet:** Insects and small rodents

30



Marsh Mongoose

Kommetjiegamuishond / Atilax paludinosus
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Freshwater with plant cover
• **Diet:** Freshwater crabs, mussels, and snails

31



Dwarf Mongoose

Dwergmuishond / Helogale parvula
• **ICUN Status:** Least concern
• **Habitat:** Woodlands
• **Diet:** Insects

32



Black Mongoose

Helogale nigrata
• **ICUN Status:** Not assessed
• **Habitat:** Mountainous regions
• **Diet:** Insects, lizards, birds, and small mammals
